A Resolution approving the City Utilities of Springfield, Transit Services' 2016 - 2019 Title VI Program, which documents how services are provided without regard to race, color or national origin; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Public Utilities views the diversity of its population as a strength and is strongly opposed to acts of discrimination; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Public Utilities recognizes the importance of ensuring practices are in place that mitigate the possibility of unintentional discrimination; and

**WHEREAS**, as a recipient of federal grant funding, City Utilities of Springfield, Transit Services must comply with the Federal Transit Administration's regulations in regard to Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 and document such practices in this Title VI Program.

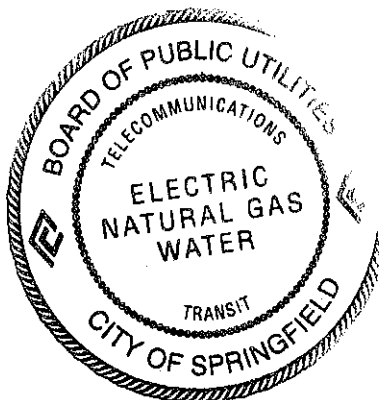


